

6-DAY SAMPLE TRIP

Singapore Culture & History



Day 1 : Singapore

Upon arrival in Singapore, our English speaking guide will be there to welcome and assist the group and prior to the transfer and check-in at the hotel, the group will head on a tour of **Jewel Changi Airport** first. Your guide will introduce you to the fascinating sights of the airport, including the **Crystal Clouds**, **HSBC Rain Vortex** and **Shiseido Forest Valley**.



Day 2 : Singapore

Today embark for your **Singapore Discovery Culture Tour**. Enjoy the history, culture and lifestyle of multi-racial Singapore. Our first visit is to **Little India**, a haven of Indian culture and ethnicity that embodies the vibrant and colourful pulse of the Indian community in Singapore with a visit to the **Sri Veeramakaliamman Temple**, a 100 year old Hindu Temple. We then proceed to **Kampong Glam** to understand more about the Malay culture, and visit Arab Street and view the magnificent **Sultan Mosque**. After we visit **Chinatown** and discover the rich heritage of Chinatown through insightful stories of Singapore's largest ethnic group, the Chinese. Then proceed to the **Buddha Relic Temple**, This majestic place of worship is a repository of Buddhist wisdom and relics, and is home to an artefact of religious reverence.



Then, we will take you on a **Bumboat River Cruise** along the Singapore River. The Singapore River is like a witness to its history. On both sides of the river, you will see the colonial buildings, traditional Chinese shops, modern skyscrapers, each of them would tell you an exciting story of Singapore.

We then visit the **Skypark Observation Deck**, 56 storeys up, in the heart of the **Marina Bay** area, this scenic view of Singapore's world-class cityscape is uniquely breath taking.





Day 3 : Singapore

This morning we proceed to a **Local Market visit** and **Cooking Class**. A Singapore cooking class offers students an opportunity to experience the diverse multiculturalism of Singaporean food. The group will meet the local chef at a local market to purchase the Asian ingredients that students will be using in the cooking class. Students will then return to the cooking kitchen studio and begin to cook their chosen Singaporean menu with the expertise and guidance from the chef. Some of the famous dishes that students can look forward to cooking include traditional dishes such as Sambal Squid, Singapore Laksa, Sambal Kangkong and Chicken Rice. This afternoon we visit the **Battle Box at Fort Canning Park**. It is a **World War II Underground Bunker Command Centre**. It was used by the Allied force as a communication centre in the war against the Japanese in the Malaya campaign in 1942 and it was where the momentous decision to surrender Singapore to the Japanese on the 15th of February 1942.



Day 4 : Singapore

This morning, students will be participating in a **Calligraphy Workshop**. Learn calligraphy, one of the highest forms of Chinese art. With a master calligrapher as your guide, practice brush techniques that depict the rhythm, lines and abstract beauty embodied in this ancient art form of expression. Students will compose their own piece to keep as a souvenir.

We then proceed to the **National Museum OF Singapore**. With a history dating back to its inception in 1887, the National Museum of Singapore is the nation's oldest museum. After we head to the **State Court Singapore**. Experience Singapore's to learn about Singapore's court system, history and architecture. Our final visit is to the **Chinatown Markets** where we test our bargaining skills and get a chance to sample the various Singapore cuisines of offer.





Day 5 : Singapore

Spend a leisurely morning exploring the **Peranakan** gems hidden in plain sight around **Joo Chiat** is one of Singapore's most storied neighbourhood. Much of the district's colourful charm from its days as a Peranakan (**Straits- born people of Chinese and Malay/Indonesian heritage**) Bask in the incredibly stylish architecture, furnishings, and the intricately painted ceramic tiles of yesteryear. After we will head to a **Tea Appreciation Workshop**. Discover the Chinese culture, art, and history of tea with this fascinating tea appreciation workshop. Learn about how tea was discovered and the tea making process during the Tang and Song Dynasty and the drink's health benefits and importance in Chinese culture, as you are taught how to properly brew and prepare it. Then proceed to the **Gardens by the Bay** which provides students with an opportunity to experience the development of modern Singapore. Students will enjoy the **Supertree Grove** and two **Conservatories** along with witnessing the evening **Garden Rhapsody light and sound show**.



Day 6 : Singapore

We check-out of the hotel and transfer to **Changi International Airport**.
