Singapore Geography & Biology



Day 1: Singapore

Upon arrival in Singapore, our English speaking guide will be there to welcome and assist the group and prior to the transfer and check-in at the hotel, the group will head on a tour of **Jewel Changi Airport** first. Your guide will introduce you to the fascinating sights of the airport, including the **Crystal Clouds, HSBC Rain Vortex** and **Shiseido Forest Valley.**



Day 2: Singapore

This morning we visit the **Sungei Buloh Wetland Reserve** which is Singapore's first ASEAN Heritage Park. Uncover a world filled with rich biodiversity as you wander through the wetlands with an extensive mangrove forest of Sungei Buloh Wetland Reserve. After, we proceed to the **Lee Kong Chian Natural History Museum** is a one-stop exhibition, education and research facility servicing a multitude of biodiversity activities in Singapore and South East Asia. This gallery tour aims to introduce students to the vast array of specimens showcased in the biodiversity and heritage galleries.



On our final visit, we proceed to the **Gardens by the Bay,** which provides students with an opportunity to experience the development of modern Singapore. Housing more than 250,000 Rare Plants and 18 Supertrees, the park is built to raise the quality of life of Singaporeans by enhancing greenery and flora in the city. Set on 54 hectares the complex consists of two climate conservatories. Appreciate the unique technologies for long-term conservation and sustainability. Students will enjoy the **Supertree Grove**, and two **Conservatories** along with witnessing the evening **Garden Rhapsody light and sound show.**







Day 3: Singapore

This morning we visit **Edible Garden City,** which is a social enterprise that champions the Grow-Your-Own-Food movement in cities around the world to improve food sustainability and resilience, starting locally with Singapore. Student will enjoy a farm tour which gives a snapshot into farming right in the heart of the city. A multisensory tour experience, featuring our unique closed-loop farming solution.



Next is a ride on a **Bumboat River Cruise** along the Singapore River. The Singapore River is like a witness of its history. At both sides of the river, you will see the colonial buildings, traditional Chinese shops, modern skyscraper each of them would tell you an exciting story of Singapore.

We then proceed to the **Skypark Observation Deck**, 56 storeys up, in the heart of the Marina Bay area, this scenic view of Singapore's world-class cityscape is uniquely breathtaking.



Day 4: Singapore

Today we enjoy a day at the **Singapore Zoo**. Set in a rainforest environment, the Singapore Zoo is home to over 2,800 animals from over 300 species of mammals, birds and reptiles. The park also boasts the world's first free-ranging orangutan habitat in a zoo. Enjoy a tram ride around what is also known as the Open Zoo - a totally new concept in animal keeping with its beautifully landscape gardens.

We then proceed next door to **Bird Paradise**, Asia's largest bird park. Experience over 3500 birds across 8 aviaries. Late afternoon will proceed to **China Town Night Markets** where we test our bargaining skills get a chance to sample the various Singapore cuisines of offer.







Day 5: Singapore

Today we make our way to **Sentosa Island** - At Sentosa Island, we provide a wide array of unique learning journey programmes suited to the curious minds of our young learners today. Here you'll visit the **Singapore Oceanarium Aquarium** - the world's largest aquarium with over 100,000 inhabitats and 800 species. Students will be given the opportunity to learn in a truly immersive learning environment. Through the lens of the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), learn about the importance of marine conservation through this tour at the Singapore Oceanarium. We then proceed next door to **Universal Studios Singapore**. Southeast Asia's first Hollywood movie theme park, which features an enticing selection of attractions, rides and entertainment for families and thrill-seekers. Visitors will find 24 movie-themed rides that were designed just for the Singapore park.

Day 6: Singapore

We check-out of the hotel and transfer to Changi International Airport.
